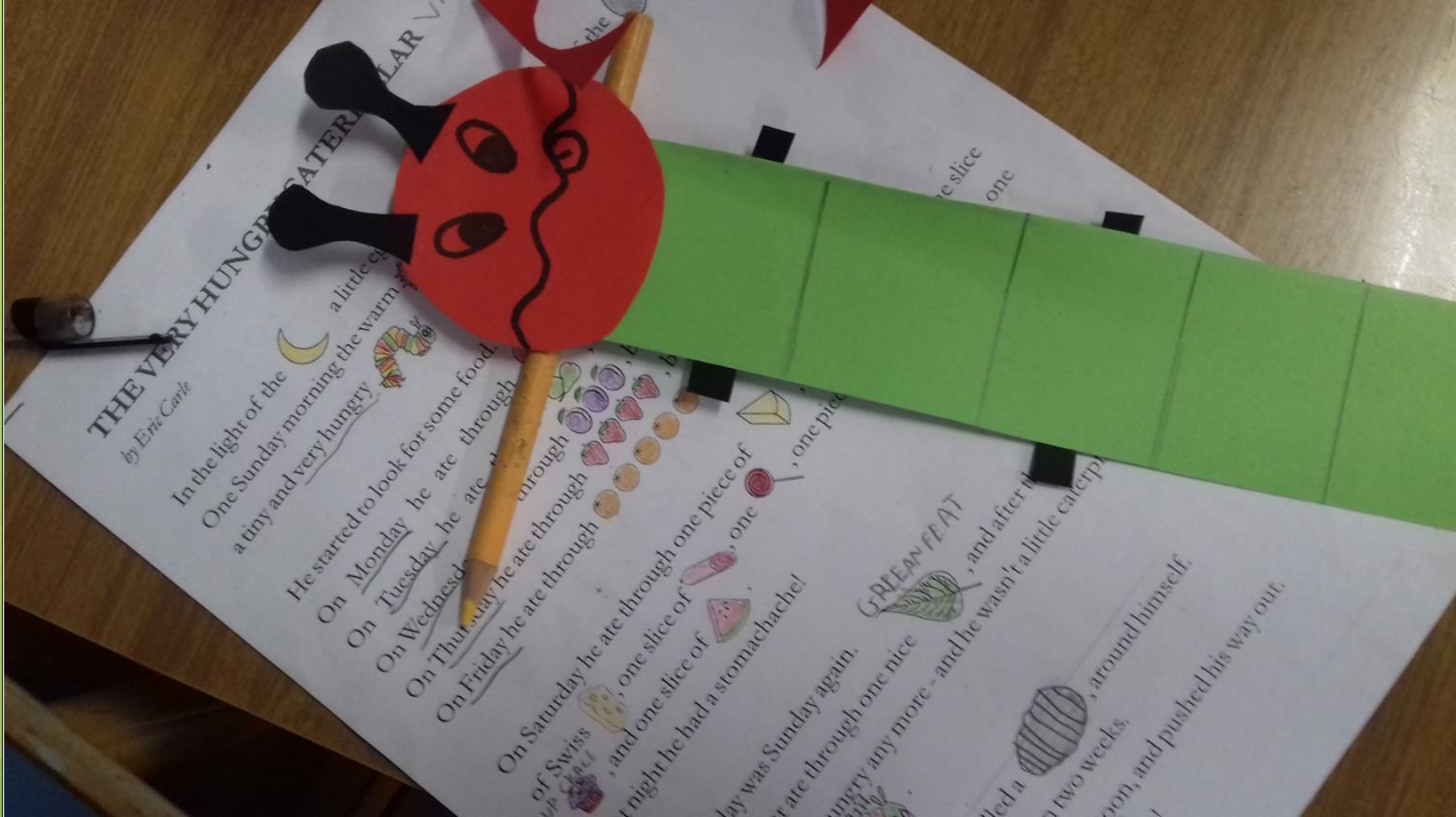

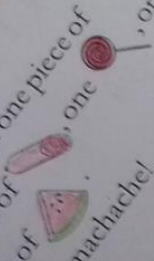
THE VERY HUNGRY CATERPILLAR

a tiny and very hungry caterpillar



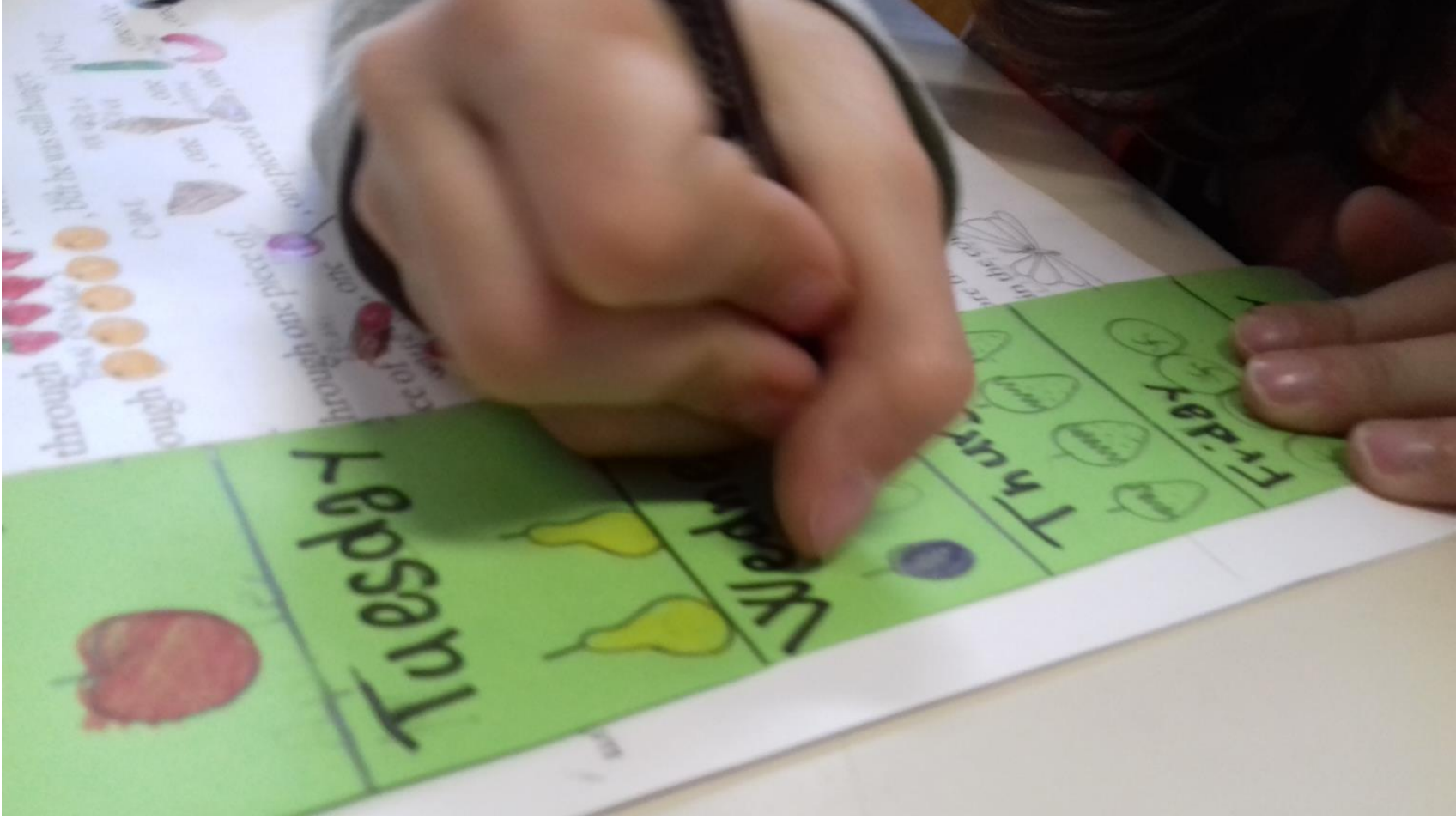
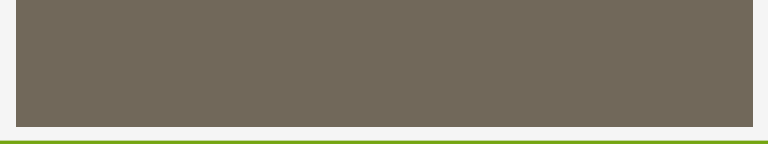
He started to look for some food.

that night he had a stomachache!







